



File preparation for printing

Correct file specifications are essential to help us with the processing of your orders properly.

- Consistent results are achieved having your images in **sRGB**. It is the most widely used and compatible profile around.
If you require a different colour space for your prints, we are more than happy to cater for that, just tell us what colour space you would like and prepare your file accordingly.
- Save your images as **JPEG** files. Use only the valid file extension of ".jpg or jpeg". Images should be at **300 dpi** at the **correct image dimensions** you require to print. On request, we can cater for other file formats if needed.
- Always keep important information such as borders, text, faces at least **5 mm** away from the edge of your print. This will help allow for movement as the paper travels through the printer.



- Please note: Stretched Canvases are wrapped around the timber frame, it needs 50mm extra allowance for the wrapping on all sides. Please take this to consideration when preparing your file for Stretched Canvases. Options are - wrap around, white sides or gallery wrapping.

- When submitting files disc/USB/, please place your images in folders named to reflect your required print size (in inches) and paper type (only if other than lustre) as shown here.
If you require multiple prints of the same image, name the folder with size and quantity.
